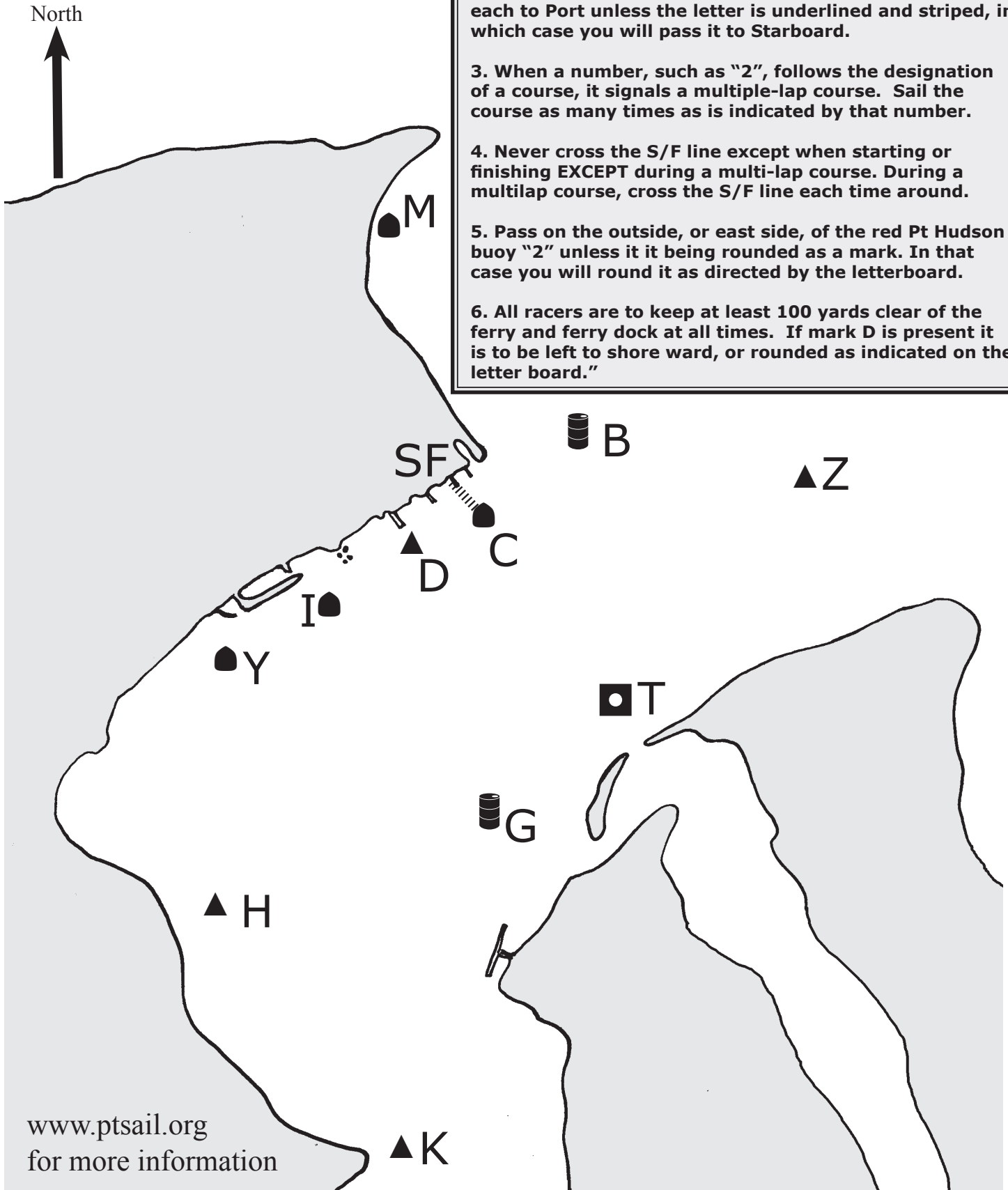

Course Instructions

1. Start in the direction of the first mark (after "S").
2. Pass, or round, each mark in the order displayed. Pass each to Port unless the letter is underlined and striped, in which case you will pass it to Starboard.
3. When a number, such as "2", follows the designation of a course, it signals a multiple-lap course. Sail the course as many times as is indicated by that number.
4. Never cross the S/F line except when starting or finishing EXCEPT during a multi-lap course. During a multilap course, cross the S/F line each time around.
5. Pass on the outside, or east side, of the red Pt Hudson buoy "2" unless it is being rounded as a mark. In that case you will round it as directed by the letterboard.
6. All racers are to keep at least 100 yards clear of the ferry and ferry dock at all times. If mark D is present it is to be left to shore ward, or rounded as indicated on the letter board."



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
