2012 Port to Port Race Instructions

This years race starts at Port Ludlow on Sunday, May 13th, at 12:00.

***The start line is at the RED "2" Dolphin near the entrance to Port Ludlow,
There will be a committee boat forming the start line at the Dolphin.***

***The finish line will be on the Port Townsend waterfront, between the City
dock and the white permanent race mark located there.***

***The course is a line drawn from the start line around the outside of
Marrowstone island, to the finish line at the City Dock.***

***It is not allowed to go inside Colvos rocks, or thru the Port Townsend
Canal.***

***This Race is administered using the Racing Rules of Sailing, as put forth
by the U.S. Sailing organization. All U.S. Coast Guard Navigation Rules
are to be followed and failure to do so may result in immediate
disqualification.***

***There will be no protests allowed, so be sure to give your competitors plenty
of room, a collision between boats causing damage or injury is an
immediate disqualification.***

***Also keep in mind we will be racing close to or thru the VTS shipping
lanes, where impeding commercial traffic is not allowed, the Coast Guard
can hand out some hefty fines if a mishap should occur.***

The time limit for this race is 6 hours, (6:00)

***Results will be posted online at PTSAIL.ORG when made available after
the race.***

***This race is for a reciprocal trophy, awarded to the club with the most
winners in the top three positions, after corrected time using standard
PHRF ratings. The winning club gets to defend the trophy the following
year, and the race alternates direction annually.***
